surplus (s+) is a Python script to convert Google Maps Plus Codes to iOS Shortcuts-like shareable text



termux users can consider surplus on wheels, a sibling project that allows you to run surplus regularly throughout the day and send it to someone on a messaging platform

i Important

python 3.11 or later is required due to a bug in earlier versions (python/cpython#88089)

install surplus with pip, or pipx (recommended):

```
pipx install surplus
```

then, use the surplus command, or its s+ shorthand:

\$ s+ 7RGX+GJ Singapore surplus version 2024.0.0 Singapore Conference Hall 7 Shenton Way 068809 Central, Singapore

the types of queries you can pass in are:

- full-length Plus Codes
 6PH58QMF+FX
- shortened Plus Codes / 'local codes'
 8QMF+FX Singapore
- latitude and longitude coordinate pairs 1.3336875, 103.7749375
- string queries
 Wisma Atria

or, alternatively pass in - to read from stdin
