

emulating termux-notification

to bodge surplus on wheels (s+ow) on non-Termux systems

`termux-notification`, part of `Termux:API`, sends out an android notification

without `termux-notification`, `s+ow` will still run as it doesn't use `set -e` and very carefully handles all command invocations, with `termux-notification` being the graceful exception\

however, if you would like to emulate it, make an executable globally reachable with the same name

`s+ow` uses the command as such:

```
termux-notification \  
  --priority "default" \  
  --title "surplus on wheels: No bridges" \  
  --content "No '$SPOW_BRIDGES' file; message is not sent."
```

```
termux-notification \  
  --priority "min" \  
  --ongoing \  
  --id "s+ow" \  
  --title "surplus on wheels" \  
  --content "s+ow has started running."
```

```
termux-notification \  
  --priority "min" \  
  --id "s+ow" \  
  --title "surplus on wheels" \  
  --content ...
```

```
termux-notification \  
  --priority "default" \  
  --title "surplus on wheels has errored" \  
  --content ...
```
